Definition of Important Terms

Base Employment – The average number of jobs in a particular industry or occupation during the benchmark year or quarter.

Current Employment Statistics (CES) – A monthly survey of business establishments that provides estimates of employment, hours, and earnings data by industry for the nation, all states, and most major metropolitan areas.

Employment – The number of jobs in a business or firm at any given time.

Establishment – The physical location of a certain economic activity, for example, a factory, mine, store, or office. Generally, a single establishment produces a single good or provides a single service.

Fastest Growing - Refers to percent growth. The higher the percent growth, the faster an industry or occupation is growing.

Industry – A group of establishments that produce similar products or provide similar services.

Metropolitan Statistical Area – A county or group of contiguous counties that contains an urban center of at least 50,000 residents and has a high degree of economic and social ties.

Net Change – The difference between projected employment and base employment.

North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) – A system used in assigning industry-designated code numbers to employers and/or establishments based on the nature of their activities, services rendered, or products delivered. It was established by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget and is used by all agencies for data compilation.

Occupation – A set of activities that employees are paid to perform; employees who perform the same tasks are in the same occupation, whether or not they are in the same industry.

Occupational Employment and Wage Statistics (OEWS) – A federal/state cooperative program that produces employment and wage estimates for over 800 occupations. These are estimates of the number of people employed in certain occupations and estimates of the wages paid to them. The estimates are also used to gather occupational staffing patterns by industry, which are used to project employment needs by occupation.

Percent (%) Change – The rate at which an industry or occupation is expected to grow or decline.

Projected Employment - The average number of jobs expected to be in an industry or occupation in the future.

Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) – A federal/state cooperative program that produces employment and wage data for workers covered by state unemployment insurance laws and federal workers covered by the Unemployment Compensation for Federal Employees Program; data is arranged by the type of industry according to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS).

Sector – A level of industry classification under supersector according to the NAICS structure.

Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) – A coding system used by all federal statistical agencies to classify workers into occupational categories for the purpose of collecting, calculating, or disseminating data.

Subsector - A level of industry classification under sector according to the NAICS structure.

Supersector – The top level of industry classification according to the NAICS structure.

Workforce Development Area – A group of contiguous counties where employment, training, and educational services are provided; established through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) to provide services for eligible youth, adults, and dislocated workers.

Methodology

The following is a brief overview of the method used to produce short-term employment projections for the local workforce development areas.

Data Development

Data development is accomplished by using three sources:

The Quarterly Census of Employment and Wage (QCEW) reports. This source provides data for all the covered employment for Arkansas. A firm or business is considered "covered" if it meets the guidelines established under the Unemployment Insurance Law.

The Current Employment Statistics (CES) Survey. This source provides employment information for non-covered establishments, which are railroads, the Federal Work Study Program, churches, religious-based schools, elected officials, commissioned insurance agents, as well as other establishments not reporting to the *QCEW* program.

Agriculture employment. This is obtained from the Census of Agriculture. The Census of Agriculture is taken every five years in years ending in two and seven. Information from the QCEW reports is used to make estimates for years following the Census year until the next Census. Other information from the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) is used to supplement agriculture employment.

Other Non-Covered Employment. Data on other agriculture employment, specifically NAICS 113, 114, and 115 as well as private households are supplemented using data from the Bureau of Economic Analysis.

Industry Projections

The industry projections in this publication were produced using the *Projections Suite System* software, authorized by the U.S. Department of Labor, and developed by the Utah Department of Workforce Services. The software has several components. The system forecasts employment using several models. The analyst chooses an appropriate forecast for each industry. All areas are done at the same time. In addition, business news related to closures, layoffs, openings, and expansions is used in the forecasting process and adjustments are made when necessary.

Occupational Projections

Occupational projections are produced by merging industries and occupations together into an industry-occupational matrix. This matrix is a table showing the occupational pattern of each industry (i.e., the ratios of employment by occupation in a specific industry). The statewide matrix is based on the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Occupational Employment and Wage Statistics (OEWS) survey and uses a Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) code for each occupation.

The occupational employment projections contained in this publication were created using the *Projections Suite System* software, authorized by the U.S. Department of Labor, and developed by the Utah Department of Workforce Services. The software applies occupational change factors to the projected patterns to form a projected matrix. In addition, using national self-employment and unpaid family workers staffing patterns, the system generates base and projected employment for self-employed and unpaid family workers.

Data Limitations

The projections contained in this publication are estimates based on historical data. It is important not to take these projections as the actual employment numbers that will occur in 2032. While every attempt is made to utilize current and near future events, such as business closings, corporate layoffs, openings, and expansions, it is not possible to know everything that is occurring or that could occur in the future. Events that take place after the projection period or announcements concerning closings, layoffs, openings, and expansions known after projections were completed are not reflected in the forecasts. In addition, legislative policy could cause employment to change. Events such as these may cause the actual employment numbers to vary significantly from these projections.

It is important to consider both numeric change and percent change when looking at projections. Industries or occupations with small employment will generally have higher growth rates than those with larger employment, but these industries may only add a few employees over the projection period. For occupational projections, it is important to look at both annual exits and annual transfers as well as the annual change. Opportunities in an occupation still exist even if the occupation is in decline.

The Northwest Arkansas Workforce Development Area (WDA) is projected to be the top and fastest growing area in the state during the 2022-2032 projection period with 33,243 new jobs anticipated to be added to the job market, a 9.62 percent change. The City of Little Rock WDA is estimated to increase the local workforce by 15,066 jobs, while the Central Arkansas WDA is projected to increase its overall workforce by 15,012 jobs. In terms of annual openings, the Northwest Arkansas WDA is projected to have 42,924 annual job openings, while the City of Little Rock WDA is estimated to have 23,795. The Eastern Arkansas WDA is predicted to have the fewest job openings with 4,397. Three areas are forecast to experience job loss. The Southeast Arkansas WDA is estimated to lose the most with 1,817 jobs expected to be cut. At a rate of 2.34 percent, the Southeast Arkansas WDA would be the fastest declining area in the state. Chart 1 on page 12 shows the percent change of total employment by Workforce Development Area as it compares to the statewide percent growth. The red line shows the statewide growth rate. Areas above the line are expected to fare better than the state, while those below the line are predicted to fare worse than the state.




The Northwest Arkansas Workforce Development Area (WDA) consists of nine counties: Baxter, Benton, Boone, Carroll, Madison, Marion, Newton, Searcy,

and Washington. The area borders two states, Missouri to the north and Oklahoma to the west. The Fayetteville-Springdale-Rogers Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is located within this area. Several large companies, including Wal-Mart and Tyson

Foods, have headquarters here, along with many trucking companies.

The Northwest Arkansas WDA has the largest employment base in the state and is predicted to be the top and fastest growing area in the state, which provides job seekers with a variety of career choices among the many industries and occupations. According to industry projections, this area is projected to add an estimated 33,243 jobs from 2022 and 2032, an increase of 9.62 percent. Goods-Producing industries are estimated to gain 2,526 jobs, while Services-Providing industries are forecast to add 29,609 jobs. An

increase of 1,108 Self-Employed Workers is anticipated between 2022 and 2032. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 2.4%.

Education and Health Services is expected to be the top growing supersector, increasing employment by 9,064 jobs. Other Services (except Government) could be the fastest growing supersector, raising employment levels by 16.12 percent. The top three fastest growing industries are in this supersector with *Business*, *Professional, Labor, Political, and Similar Organizations* leading with a growth of 67.44 percent. *Management of Companies and Enterprises* is slated to be the top



Projected Employment Growth (2022-2032): 9.62% Unemployment Rate (Not-seasonally-adjusted Avg.) (2022): 2.4% growing industry with an increase of 5,012 jobs. On the negative side of the labor market, *Animal Production* is predicted to lose 415 jobs, or

17.97 percent of its workforce, while *Mining (except Oil and Gas)* is forecast to cut41.56 percent of its workforce, becoming the fastest declining industry in the area.In all, the **Natural Resources and Mining** supersector could lose 12.06 percent of



its local workforce.

According to occupational projections, the Northwest Arkansas WDA is projected to have 42,924 annual job openings, of which 17,612 would be created from employees leaving the workforce, 21,988 from those changing jobs, and 3,324 from growth and expansion. **Management Occupations** is predicted to be the top growing major group, adding 3,778 new jobs, while the **Computer and Mathematical Occupations** major group is slated to increase its workforce by 25.97 percent, becoming the fastest growing major group. *Home Health and Personal Care*

Aides is projected to increase its workforce by 1,408 jobs, becoming the top growing occupation, while *Nurse Practitioners* could be the fastest growing occupation, increasing its ranks by 60.50 percent. On the negative side of the labor market, the **Farming, Fishing, and Forestry Occupations** major group is estimated to lose 255 jobs, or 9.55 percent of its workforce. *Farmers, Ranchers, and Other Agricultural Managers* is predicted to cut 235 jobs, becoming the top declining occupation, while *Data Entry Keyers* is expected to lose 21.78 percent of its workforce, becoming the fastest declining occupation.

The North Central Arkansas Workforce Development Area (WDA) consists of 10 counties: Cleburne, Fulton, Independence, Izard, Jackson,

Sharp, Stone, Van Buren White, and Woodruff, with the state of Missouri bordering the area to the north.

According to industry projections, the North Central Arkansas WDA is projected to add 4,804 jobs from 2022 through 2032, increasing employment by 5.63 percent. Goods-Producing industries are expected to have a net gain of 1,400 jobs, while the Services-Providing industries could add 3,318. The area is predicted to experience a gain of 86 jobs in Self-Employed Workers, an increase of 0.90 percent of its workforce. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.7 percent.

Education and Health Services is projected to be the top growing supersector in the North Central Arkansas WDA with a gain of 1,409 jobs. *Ambulatory Health Care Services*

leads all industries in numeric change, anticipating 876 new jobs to the local economy. **Professional and Business Services** is predicted to be the fastest growing supersector, increasing its workforce by 16.84 percent. *Business, Professional, Labor, Political, and Similar Organizations* is slated to be the fastest growing industry, increasing its workforce by 57.64 percent by 2032. On the negative side of *Government, Excluding Post Office* could lose 27.71 percent of its local workforce, becoming the fastest declining industry. Overall, the **Government** supersector could cut 217 jobs, or 4.07 percent of its workforce.

According to occupational projections, the area is expected to have 10,278 total job openings annually between 2022 and 2032. Of these, 4,523 would be from those exiting the workforce, while 5,275 would be from those changing jobs. Another 480 would be related to growth and expansion. **Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations** is predicted to be the top growing major group, adding 711 new jobs, while **Healthcare Support Occupations** is slated to be the fastest growing major group, increasing its workforce by 16.16 percent. *Home Health and Personal Care Aides* is projected to raise staffing levels by 326 jobs, becoming the

top growing occupation. *Nurse Practitioners* is estimated to increase its workforce by 60.74 percent during the projection period. On the negative side of the labor market, *Cashiers* is projected to lose 114 jobs by 2032, becoming the top declining occupation, while *Forest and Conservation Technicians* is forecast to cut over a quarter of its workforce, becoming the fastest declining occupation.

supersector could lose 128 jobs, or 19.08 percent of its workforce.

According to occupational projections, the Northeast Arkansas WDA is expected

Occupations is forecast to be the fastest growing major group, increasing its workforce by 23.29 percent.
Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care*

Aides, which is slated to grow by 725 employees. On the declining side of the local labor market, *Miscellaneous Assemblers and Fabricators* is projected to lose 231 jobs during the projection period. *Broadcast Announcers and Radio Disc Jockeys* could lose a third of its workforce, becoming the fastest declining occupation in Northeast Arkansas. Overall, the **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** is predicted to lose 272 jobs, or 2.30 percent of its workforce.

The Northeast Arkansas WDA is expected to gain 6,791 jobs, an increase of 5.71 percent between 2022 and 2032. Goods-Producing industries are predicted to experience a net gain of 1,326 jobs, while Services-Providing industries could see an increase of 5,434. The self-employed ranks could see a small growth of 31 jobs, a 0.39 percent gain. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.3 percent.

Education and Health Services is expected to be the top growing supersector, adding 3,101 new jobs.

Natural Resources and Mining is anticipated to be the

fastest growing supersector, increasing its workforce by 15.43 percent. *Social Assistance* is estimated to add 1,249 jobs to the labor market, becoming the top growing industry in the Northeast Arkansas WDA. *Animal Production and Aquaculture* is forecast to more than double in size between 2022 and 2032, becoming the fastest growing industry. On the negative side of the economy, *Transportation Equipment Manufacturing* is slated to be the top declining

The **Manufacturing** supersector is expected to experience a decline of 427 jobs, or 1.99 percent of its workforce. Leading this



According to occupational projections, Western Arkansas employers are projected

to have 13,968 annual job openings. Of these, 6,028 are estimated to come from occupational exits, 7,392 from occupational transfers, and 548 due to growth and expansion of jobs. **Healthcare Support Occupations** is predicted to be the top and fastest growing major group, increasing by 881 jobs, or 18.03 percent. Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care Aides*, which is forecast to increase staffing by 561 jobs, a 32.98 percent rise in staffing. *Nurse Practitioners* is estimated to be the fastest growing occupation in the area with a gain of 59.65 percent. On the negative side of the



The West Central Arkansas Workforce Development Area (WDA) consists of 10 counties: Clark, Conway, Garland, Hot Spring, Johnson, Montgomery,

Perry, Pike, Pope, and Yell; with the Hot Springs Metropolitan Statistical Area located within the WDA.

According to industry projections, the West Central Arkansas WDA is estimated to experience a gain of 6,427 jobs, a 5.20 percent increase by 2032. Goods-Producing industries are projected to see a net gain of 1,224 jobs, while the Services-Providing industries are predicted to add 5,072. There is estimated to be 131 more Self-Employed Workers in this area by 2032. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.8 percent.

Education and Health Services is predicted to be the top growing supersector, adding 1,906 new jobs to the local labor market. *Ambulatory Health Care Services* is slated to add 1,099 new jobs by 2032. *Grantmaking and Giving Services* is predicted to be the fastest growing industry, increasing by 37.72 percent between 2022 and 2032. **Construction** is estimated to be the fastest growing supersector, increasing its workforce by 12.46 percent. On the negative side of the labor market, *Federal Government, Excluding Post Office* could cut 194 jobs, or more than a quarter of its workforce, becoming the top and fastest declining industry in West

Central Arkansas. Overall, Government jobs could be cut by 238, or 3.16 percent of its local workforce.

According to occupational

projections, the West Central Arkansas WDA is estimated to have 15,133 annual job openings during the projection period. Of these, 6,552 openings could be due to those exiting the workforce, 7,938 from those changing jobs, and 643 due to growth and expansion. **Transportation and Material Moving Occupations** is estimated to be the top growing major group, adding 1,168 jobs to the labor market, an 8.99 percent increase. **Healthcare Support Occupations** is predicted to be the fastest growing supersector, increasing its workforce by 19.21 percent. Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care* Aides, which is predicted to add 601 jobs

to its ranks, an almost 32 percent growth. *Nurse Practitioners* is forecast to be the fastest growing occupation, estimated to raise its workforce by 58 percent over the next ten years. On the negative side of the economy, *Farmers, Ranchers, and Other Agricultural Managers* is projected to lose 170 jobs, becoming the top declining occupation, or 3.06 percent of its workforce, while *Sewing Machine Operators* could cut 54.55 percent from its workforce, becoming the fastest declining occupation in the area.

The Central Arkansas Workforce Development Area (WDA) consists of six counties, all within commuting distance of the City of

Little Rock WDA: Faulkner, Lonoke, Monroe, Prairie, Saline, and the portion of Pulaski County outside of Little Rock. The majority of the Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway Metropolitan Statistical Area is in this area.

According to industry projections, the area is expected to experience a gain of 15,012 jobs, an increase of 7.87 percent. Goods-Producing industries are projected to experience a net gain of 1,115 new jobs, while the Services-Providing industries are predicted to gain 13,569 jobs. Self-Employed Workers is slated to experience a gain of 328 workers. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.0 percent.

Education and Health Services is predicted to be the top growing supersector, adding 3,784 jobs to the local economy. **Other Services (except Government)** is

estimated to be the fastest growing major group, increasing its workforce by 27.48 percent. *Grantmaking and Giving Services* is slated to be the top growing industry in Central Arkansas, adding 2,418 new jobs to its workforce. *Religious Organizations* is projected to be the second highest growing industry and the fastest growing, anticipated to grow by 2,363 jobs, a 44.45 percent rise in employment. On the negative side of the economy, *Paper Manufacturing* is predicted to be the top declining industry, cutting 245 jobs from its workforce, while *Textile Product Mills*

is forecast to be the fastest declining industry, cutting 29.17 percent from its already small workforce.

According to occupational projections, the Central Arkansas WDA is expected to have 23,629 annual job openings during the projection period, with 9,218 being

created due to employees exiting the workforce, 12,910 created due to employees changing jobs, and 1,501 due to growth and expansion. **Transportation and Material Moving Occupations** leads all major groups in numeric change, increasing its overall workforce by 2,266 jobs. **Community and Social Service Occupations** is predicted to be the fastest growing major group, adding an estimated 32.94 percent to its workforce. Driving this growth is *Clergy*, which is expected to add 974 jobs to its ranks, a 46.20 percent increase. *Nurse Practitioners* could be the fastest growing occupation, raising employment levels by 55.60 percent between 2022 and 2032. On the negative side of

the local economy, *Farmers, Ranchers, and Other Agricultural Managers* could see a job reduction of 129, while *Adult Basic Education, Adult Secondary Education, and English as a Second Language Instructors* is slated to experience a 27.27 percent loss of its small local workforce. The **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** major group could see a drop of 63 jobs from its workforce between 2022 and 2032.

The City of Little Rock Workforce Development Area (WDA) is a center for government operations, serving as the county seat of Pulaski County as well as the state's capital. The WDA is

recognized as part of the Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway Metropolitan Statistical Area.

According to industry projections, the City of Little Rock WDA is expected to gain 15,066 jobs between 2022 and 2032, an increase of 7.14 percent. Goods-Producing industries are projected to experience a net gain of 1,430 jobs, while the Services-Providing industries are predicted to gain 13,292. Self-Employed Workers is expected to increase by 344 jobs. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.4 percent.

Education and Health Services is estimated to be the top growing supersector, adding 4,619 new jobs,

an 8.37 percent gain. **Manufacturing** is projected to see a gain of 17.55 percent, becoming the fastest growing supersector. Driving this growth is *Wood Product Manufacturing*, which is anticipated to be the fastest growing industry in the City of Little Rock WDA, experiencing a 1,626.67 percent growth between 2022 and 2032. *Insurance Carriers* is predicted to be the top growing industry, increasing its workforce by 2,166 jobs. On the negative side of the labor market, *Private Households* is slated to decline by 197 jobs, while *Support Activities for Agriculture and Forestry* could see a 30.77 percent reduction in its workforce. Overall,



Information is predicted to be the top and fastest declining supersector, cutting an estimated 366 jobs, or 15.92 percent of its workforce.

According to occupational projections, City of Little Rock WDA employers are expected to have 23,795 annual openings during the projection period. Of these,

9,924 would be created due to employees leaving the workforce, while 12,364 would be created due to employees changing jobs. Around 1,507 job openings could be available annually due to growth and expansion of the workforce. Healthcare
Practitioners and Technical Occupations is estimated to be the top growing major group, increasing its workforce by 2,183 jobs. Computer and Mathematical Occupations is slated to be the fastest growing major group, raising employment levels by 14.90 percent. Home Health and Personal

Care Aides is predicted to be the top growing occupation, increasing by 835 jobs. *Tour and Travel Guides* is estimated to more than double in employment during the projection period, becoming the fastest growing occupation. On the negative side of the local job market, *Secretaries and Administrative Assistants, Except Legal, Medical, and Executive* is forecast to lose 122 jobs during the projection period, while *Word Processors and Typists* is predicted to cut a third of its workforce during the projection period, becoming the fastest declining occupation in the area.



Crittenden County makes up a portion of the Memphis Metropolitan Statistical Area, the forty-third largest in population in the United States according to the Census Bureau.

With a net loss of 474 jobs, or 1.22 percent decrease, this WDA is one of three areas in the state to experience a decline of jobs. Goods-Producing industries are projected to experience a net loss of 337 jobs, while the Services-Providing industries are predicted to experience a small net gain of eight jobs. Self-Employed Workers are predicted to lose 145 jobs, or 4.90 percent of the workforce. The not-seasonallyadjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 4.3 percent.

Leisure and Hospitality is estimated to be one of only three supersectors in the Eastern Arkansas WDA expected to see growth, adding 183 jobs, a 4.26 percent increase. Professional and Business Services is slated to be the fastest growing supersector, increasing its workforce by 5.72 percent. *Warehousing and Storage* is forecast to be the top and fastest growing industry, increasing its workforce by 58.87 percent, or 282 new jobs between 2022 and 2032. On the negative side of the job market, Manufacturing is predicted to be the top declining supersector, losing 174 jobs, while Financial Activities is forecast to be the fastest declining supersector, cutting 6.91 percent from its workforce. *Elementary and Secondary Schools* is slated to be the top declining industry, with a drop of 299 jobs, while *Fabricated Metal*



projections, the Eastern Arkansas WDA is expected to have 4,397 annual job

openings during the projection period, with 2,004 being created due to employees leaving the workforce and 2,440 related to those changing jobs. Job opportunities related to growth and expansion could be reduced by 47 jobs annually. **Transportation and Material Moving Occupations** is estimated to be the top growing major group, adding 212 jobs to its workforce, while **Healthcare Support Occupations** is expected to be the fastest growing major group, increasing its workforce by 12.53 percent. Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care Aides*, which is slated to add 181 new jobs during the projection period. *Nurse Practitioners* is projected to be the fastest

growing occupation, gaining 40 percent more workers between 2022 and 2032. On the negative side of the labor market, *Cashiers* is forecast to cut 184 jobs from its workforce, becoming the top declining occupation, while *Structural Metal Fabricators and Fitters* could reduce its already small local workforce by 41.18 percent, becoming the fastest declining occupation in the area. Eight major groups are predicted to see job loss. **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** are estimated to lose 326 jobs, while **Sales and Related Occupations** could cut 9.21 percent from its workforce.



Twelve counties are located within this region: Calhoun, Columbia, Dallas, Hempstead, Howard, Lafayette, Little River, Miller, Nevada, Ouachita, Sevier, and Union. Three states border the area: Oklahoma to the west, Texas to the southwest, openings annually. Of these, 4,275 annual openings are due to employees leaving the workforce and 5,255 from those changing jobs. However, the overall decline in employment could reduce annual job openings by 80. **Transportation and**

and Louisiana to the south. Miller County is part of the Texarkana AR/TX Metropolitan Statistical Area.

According to industry projections, employment is projected to see a reduction of 800 jobs, or 0.92 percent of its workforce. Goods-Producing industries are predicted to experience a net loss of 772 jobs, while Services-Providing industries are estimated to see a net gain of 236 jobs. The area is expected to cut 264 Self-Employed Workers during the 2022-2032 projection cycle. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 3.9 percent.



Material Moving Occupations is predicted to grow by 316 jobs, becoming the top growing major group. Healthcare Support Occupations is slated to be the fastest growing major group, raising employment levels by 9.45 percent. Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care Aides*, which is predicted to increase its workforce by 251 jobs, becoming the top growing occupation in the area. *Nurse Practitioners* is estimated to grow by 39.16 percent, becoming the fastest growing industry. On the negative side of the local economy, *Farmers, Ranchers, and Other Agricultural Managers* is set to be the top declining occupation, losing an

Professional and Business Services is predicted to be the top and fastest growing supersector, with a gain of 236 employees between 2022 and 2032, an increase of 5.22 percent. *Social Assistance* is projected to be the top growing industry, increasing employment by 290 jobs, or 14.27 percent. *Grantmaking and Giving Services* could be the fastest growing industry, increasing its workforce by 31.58 percent. On the other side of the labor market, *Machinery Manufacturing* is anticipated to lose 716 jobs, or more the 80 percent of its workforce by 2032, becoming the top and fastest declining industry in Southwest Arkansas.

estimated 306 jobs, while *Broadcast Announcers and Radio Disc Jockeys* is projected to cut 34.78 percent of its already small local workforce, becoming the fastest declining occupation in Southwest Arkansas. Overall, **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** could be the top declining major group with 726 jobs being cut, while **Farming, Fishing, and Forestry Occupations** could be the fastest declining major group, cutting 14.63 percent from its workforce.

According to industry projections, the Southeast Arkansas WDA is expected to lose the most jobs of any workforce area, cutting 1,817 jobs between 2022 and 2032, a 2.34 percent decline. Goods-Producing industries are projected to experience a net loss of 973 jobs, while the Services-Providing industries are predicted to experience a net loss of 547 jobs. The area could experience a decrease of 297 Self-Employed Workers. The not-seasonally-adjusted average unemployment rate for 2022 was 4.5 percent, the highest in the state.

Leisure and Hospitality is predicted to be the top

growing supersector, with a gain of 307 employees between 2022 and 2032, an increase of 5.76 percent. **Professional and Business Services** is forecast to raise employment levels by 6.63 percent, becoming the fastest growing supersector. *Social Assistance* is projected to be the top growing industry, increasing employment by 258 jobs, or 10.71 percent. *Waste Management and Remediation Services* is slated to be the fastest growing industry, increasing its workforce by 38.64 percent. On the negative side of the labor market, *Paper Manufacturing* is set to lose 568 jobs, becoming the top declining industry, while *Newspaper, Periodical, Book, and*

annually during the 2022-2032 projection period. Of these, 3,805 would be from employees leaving the workforce, while 4,671 could be created from those changing jobs. Growth and expansion could be reduced by 182 job openings each year. **Healthcare Support Occupations** is projected to be the top and fastest growing major group, adding 271 jobs to its workforce, an increase of 8.88 percent. Driving this growth is *Home Health and Personal Care Aides*, which is slated to add 271 jobs to the labor market. *Personal Financial Advisors* is projected to be the fastest growing industry, adding 56.63 percent to its workforce. On the negative side of the local economy,

Farmers, Ranchers, and Other Agricultural Managers is anticipated to cut 277 jobs, while *Advertising Sales Agents* is slated to have a 37.50 percent reduction in its small local workforce. **Office and Administrative Support Occupations** is expected to be the top and fastest declining major group, losing an estimated 708 jobs, or 8.68 percent of its workforce. Overall, 13 of the 22 major groups are set to experience a net loss of jobs between 2022 and 2032.



Directory Publishers is forecast to cut 62.32 percent of its workforce between 2022 and 2032. Overall, the **Information** supersector could cut
